FLAME WINDSHIELD TRIM FOR 1996 AND NEWER FLH MODELS
#HD800

The windshield trim may be installed either on top of the fairing or between the fairing and the windshield. In either case take care not to scratch the fairing or windshield while installing the trim.

1. Remove the three screws, which hold the windshield to the fairing.

Installing over the fairing;

Place the trim over the fairing, align the center hole and start the screw into the hole. Start the other two screws into their holes then tighten all three securely.

Installing between the windshield and fairing;

Have another person help pull the fairing away from the windshield about $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Flex the trim to the curved contour of the fairing and windshield and carefully slide it down into position aligning the center hole first. Start the center screw into its hole, next align the remaining two holes and start the screws. Tighten all three screws. It is normal for some of the flames to touch the windshield when mounted in this position. You may choose to bend them out slightly or if you want them all to touch the windshield you may have to remove the trim and bend the flames in slightly then reinstall the trim.
