Read your installation instructions completely before beginning. This light bar can be installed in just a few minutes using common tools. It is recommended however, that a qualified mechanic or technician install this product.

1. Your Light Bar comes with everything you need to mount and wire it to your motorcycle. After unpacking the light bar, you will need to turn the spot lights around 180 degrees. They are facing backwards for packaging purposes only.
2. Remove your headlight bulb assembly and unplug your turn signals and remove them from their original mounts. Mount them to the aluminum fittings underneath the light bar using the stock turn signal mounting screw. Remove the original turn signal mount bar and set it aside. Be sure to unbolt the head light support.
3. Install your Light Bar on the lower triple tree using the original hardware. Align the assembly and tighten the two bolts to factory torque specs. Align the turn signals and spotlights. Check to make sure the screws on top of the light bar frame that hold the turn signal adapters are snug. Install the supplied 6mm Hex Bolt, Spacer, and Washer into the hole at the bottom of the headlight.
4. Feed the wire from the light bar switch through the back of the headlight housing. Attach the wire from the switch to the blue running light wire using the blue quick splice clip supplied. Twist the ends of the 2 spotlight wires together and insert them into the supplied push on connector and crimp with wire crimp tool. Connect this to one pole on your light bar switch, it doesn't matter which one.
5. Plug your turn signal wires back into their original location. Re-install the headlight bulb assembly back into its housing. **Check to make sure your handlebars turn lock to lock without any stretching or binding of any wires.** Check the alignment of all your lighting. Make sure everything is working properly before riding.
